Hospice Diagnosis Indicators *

**Indicators for receiving hospice evaluation. Eligibility criteria will be applied during evaluation for hospice.*

HIV/AIDS

- Weight loss and weakness
- ADL assistance
- Increasing Infections
- Change in lab values

NEUROLOGICAL

(CVA, Parkinsons, ALS, etc.)

- Impaired swallowing, breathing
- Limited speech
- ADL assistance
- Weight loss and weakness

DEMENTIA/ALZHEIMERS

- Verbally limited
- Non-ambulatory
- Incontinent of bowel or bladder
- ADL assistance required

CANCER

- Metastases
- Tx no longer slows progression
- Continued weight loss
- ADL assistance

CARDIAC

- Shortness of breath at rest
- Recurrent symptom of CHF
- Ejection fraction 20% or less
- Activity intolerance

LIVER DISEASE

- Serum albumin < 2.5gm/dl
- PT > 5 sec over control or INR > 1.5
- Jaundice
- Ascites

PULMONARY DISEASE

- Hypoxemia- < 88% on room air OR
- Hypercapnia- $pCO_2 > 50$ mmHg
- Disabling dyspnea at rest
- Frequent respiratory infections

STROKE OR COMA

- Irreversible damage, vegetative state
- Inability to swallow
- Need for total care
- Poor nutritional status

NON – SPECIFIC TERMINAL ILLNESS

- Recent Clinical/Functional decline
- Significant weight loss, or BMI < 22
- Increase in ER, Physician visits
- Progression of cognitive impairment
- ADL assistance
- Other Co-morbidities that attribute to decline

General Guidelines

- ✓ Frequent Hospitalizations
- ✓ Frequent Physician or ER visits
- ✓ Deteriorating mental status
- ✓ Recurrent infections
- ✓ Progressive weight loss
